

SUSTAINABLE FORESTRY

POLICY SUMMARY

Mativ Holdings, Inc., and its subsidiaries (“Mativ”) commit to delivering products to customers that match their expectations and to procuring forest risk commodities (namely timber products and rubber) sourced from legally harvested and well-managed forests. This commitment is our responsibility to our customers, employees, and stakeholders, and it is a cornerstone of our broader sustainability strategy.

APPLICABILITY

This Policy applies to all Mativ business units consuming forest risk commodities. Mativ is committed to working with and encouraging our suppliers and distributors to uphold the principles set forth in this Policy and to adopt similar policies within their own businesses.

POLICY SPECIFICS

Purchasing Policy

We hereby commit to the respect of fundamental principles and to continuously improve the sustainability of our sourcing through the following practices:

- We ensure that all wood fiber and pulp purchased are legally compliant: of known origin, obtained through non-controversial sourcing, and harvested with respect to applicable laws and human rights. Given the localization of our operations and markets, we particularly focus on compliance to the Brazilian Forest Code, EU Timber Regulation, USA Lacey Act, and CITES.
- We support stricter and more credible third-party certification schemes and associated sourcing requirements, such as FSC, PEFC, SFI, and equivalent standards.
- We work with our suppliers to communicate our requirements and to evaluate their performance through periodic assessments.
- We attain the certification of our operations to the Chain of Custody standard which is most relevant to the specific market and country.
- We communicate with policymakers, monitoring organizations, and other stakeholders as necessary to respond to inquiries and to raise global awareness about the environmental, social, and economic value of forests.
- We implement the relevant procedures and train the appropriate persons (employees and other stakeholders) involved in the chain of custody.

SUSTAINABLE FORESTRY

- We ensure that our system is audited internally and by third parties as required to demonstrate its efficacy and compliance.

Milestones and Targets

- 2017: All wood fiber and pulp purchased bear the FSC Mix, FSC Recycled, or FSC Controlled Wood label and/or are provided by suppliers holding FSC and/or PEFC Chain of Custody certification.
- 2023: All Mativ sites processing wood fiber and/or pulp will be FSC and/or PEFC Chain of Custody certified.

KEY TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

Term	Definition
FSC Mix	The product is made with a mixture of materials from FSC-certified forests, recycled materials, and/or FSC controlled wood.
FSC Recycled	The product is made from 100 percent recycled materials. Using recycled material makes the most of precious forest resources and reduces the pressure to harvest more trees.
FSC Controlled Wood	This is material from acceptable sources (areas covered by the FSC system) that can be mixed with FSC-certified material in products that carry the FSC Mix label. It mitigates the risk of forest products originating from unacceptable sources.
FSC Chain of Custody	FSC Chain of Custody certification traces the path of products from forests through the supply chain, verifying that FSC-certified material is identified or kept separate from non-certified material throughout the chain.
PEFC Chain of Custody	PEFC Chain of Custody establishes the link from the forest to the market, tracking forest-based products from sustainable sources to the final product.
